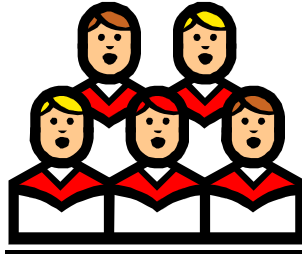
Art (grades K-3) / Instructor Mrs. Morin / Room 113 / Wed 3-4 pm / Supply fee: \$20

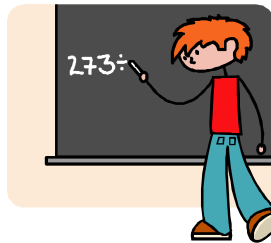
Music (grades K-8) Instructor: Mrs. Kinsey / Room 114

Music K-3rd: Mondays from 3:00 – 4:00

This class will really enjoy the songs and games we will learn that teach musical concepts. From the basic building blocks of music to some reading and writing music, they will have fun playing rhythm instruments, body percussion and making their own homemade instruments. They will be given a music notebook for worksheets that they will bring home in December and learn sign language with worship songs. They will also perform a few songs for the Christmas showcase during school in December. They will receive instruction in vocal care, vocal exercises and matching pitch from a professional music teacher and vocal performer. The goal for this class is to learn all about music in a fun way.

Music 4-8th: Wednesdays from 3:00 – 4:00

This class will really enjoy the variety of songs, games, & instruments we will learn that teach many aspects in the field of music and performance. Students will apply learning the musical staff to reading music and writing their own songs. They will be given a music notebook for theory worksheets and will enjoy applying their theory to playing the glockenspiels and the bell plates. They will be able to express their love for the Lord in worship songs and sign-language while learning how to care and strengthen their voices. They will also perform a few songs for the Christmas showcase during school in December. They will receive performance instruction on how the power of music impacts us spiritually, emotionally & physically from a professional music teacher & vocal performer.
